Teaching Cultures Survey: publication plans and confidentiality statement

Each participating university will be named as one of the 18-20 universities taking part in the Teaching Cultures Survey; otherwise NO INFORMATION relating to the findings from any individual institutional survey will be available in the public domain or seen by anyone outside the university. So there will be no university-by-university comparisons and there will be no way of inferring any of the findings from any individual university from the amalgamated data.

Following each data capture point (in 2019, 2021 and 2023), a snap-shot of the survey findings from the amalgamated data set (across all 18-20 institutions) will be included in a summary report which will be made available on the project website. In both the website and report, we will list the participating universities, but no information about individual findings will be included.

The bespoke reports and spreadsheets (given to each participating university) will be the only place where the university's own findings will be isolated, and these results will be strictly confidential. These findings will only be seen by the project lead (Dr Ruth Graham) and the project research/design team, and will be sent only to the university's appointed institutional and administrative leads.
